


## YOUTH MARIJUANA USE IN LEGALIZED STATES



YOUTH MARIJUANA USE IS NOT REDUCED OR TEMPERED STATES THAT HAVE LEGALIZED RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA

AMONG STUDENTS WHO **SMOKE** MARIJUANA IN COLORADO, THOSE WHO REPORTED "DABBING" OR VAPING INCREASED BY 9.5% AMONG 11<sup>™</sup> GRADERS AND 8.7% BY 12TH **GRADERS** FROM 2016 TO 2017.



**52%** OF YOUTH AGES 12-20 REPORT OBTAINING MARIJUANA FOR FREE, WITHOUT CONCESSION.

OF THOSE WHO REPORTED OBTAINING MARIJUANA BUY PURCHASE, 32% SAID THEY GOT IT FROM A FRIEND AND 7% SAID THEY BOUGHT IT FROM A STRANGER
