HOW THE POLL WAS CONDUCTED

This poll was conducted by Mason-Dixon Polling & Research, Inc. of Jacksonville, Florida from June 5 through June 9, 2019. A total of 1,000 adults were interviewed nationwide by telephone.

Those interviewed were randomly selected from a list of working phone numbers that included both land-lines and mobile phones. Quotas were assigned in order to reflect adult population by state.

The margin for error, according to standards customarily used by statisticians, is no more than ± 3.2 percentage points. This means that there is a 95 percent probability that the "true" figure would fall within that range if all adults were surveyed. The margin for error is higher for any subgroup, such as a gender or age grouping.

The survey includes 676 adults who indicated they were registered to vote. The margin for error among registered voters is ± 3.8 percentage points.

QUESTION: Currently, possessing and selling marijuana is against federal law. Which one of the following best describes your preference on national marijuana policy?

- Keep the current policy of outlawing marijuana possession and sale
- Keep the current policy, but legalize marijuana for medical use
- Decriminalize marijuana possession by removing the possibility of jail time and also allowing medical marijuana use, but keep the sale of marijuana illegal.
- Legalize the commercial production, possession and sale of marijuana for recreational use, as some states have done.
